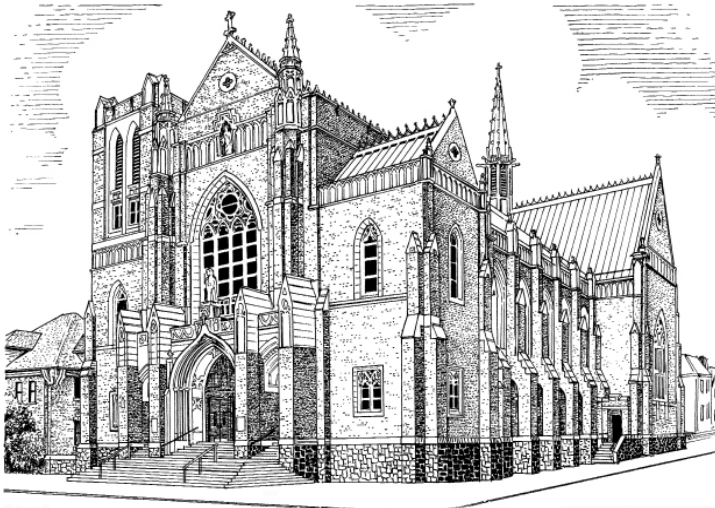

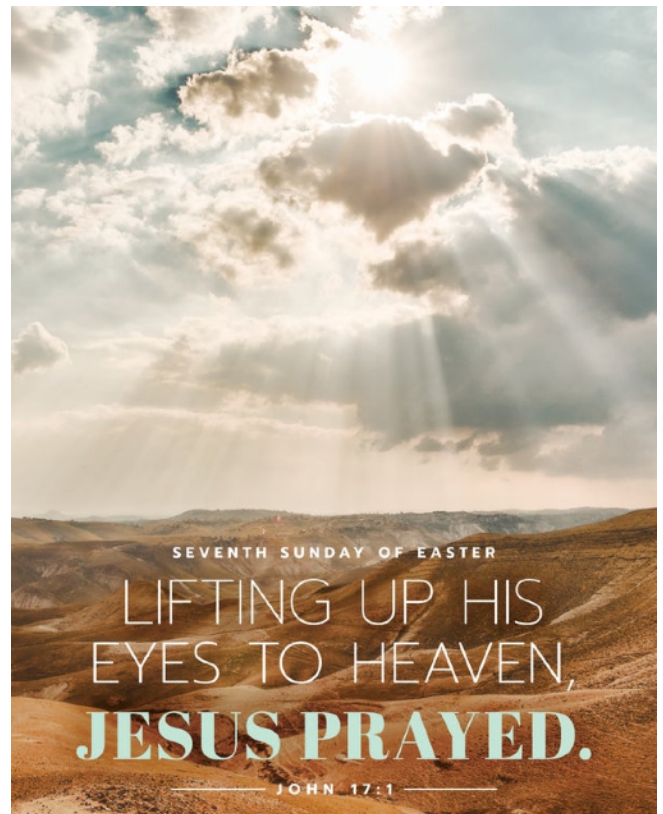

Sacraments at Our Parish

Baptism | *Bautismo*:



Baptism is the first sacrament of initiation through which one becomes part of the Body of Christ, the Catholic Church. We usually celebrate Baptism on the last weekend of each month. To schedule one, contact the Rectory **a month or more** before to speak with a priest.

Oración sacerdotal de Jesús.



In the gospels, not only do we find Jesus praying, but we also hear him inviting us to be men and women of prayer. We also find beautiful prayers that Jesus prayed. Among the most important, we find:

1. The Lord's Prayer: This is considered the most important prayer taught by Jesus to his disciples. In it, Jesus teaches us to address God as Father and to ask his will for our lives.
2. Prayer in Gethsemane: Before being arrested and crucified, Jesus retired to pray in the garden of Gethsemane. In this prayer, Jesus expressed his anguish and surrendered his life to the will of the Father: "Father, if it be your will, take this cup from me; But not my will, but yours, be done" (Luke 22:42).
3. Prayer on the cross: Just before dying on the cross, Jesus uttered several powerful prayers, including: "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they do" (Luke 23:34) and "My God, my God, why What have you abandoned me?" (Matthew 27:46). These prayers reflect Jesus' compassion and suffering for humanity.
4. Prayer for his disciples: In chapter 17 of the Gospel of John, Jesus said a prayer for his disciples before being arrested. In this prayer, Jesus asked the Father to protect them and keep them together: "Holy Father, keep those whom you have given me in your name... that they may be one, just as we are one" (John 17:11). These are just a few of the many important prayers spoken by Jesus during his earthly life. Each one reveals his deep bond with God and his love for humanity.

The gospel of this Seventh Sunday of Easter focuses on this last prayer for his disciples, also known as priestly prayer. The priestly prayer refers to Jesus' prayer before his arrest. In it, Jesus delivers his spiritual testament. In this text, Christ takes stock of his life before entering his Passion. This is one of the most intense moments of the Master's life.

"Holy Father, keep these whom you have given me in your name so they may be like us." Jesus clarifies that the union between him and the apostles is not a simple friendship that ends in feeling. He asks for them to have unity as intimate as divine unity. He asks that, although they remain in the world, they be separated from it as He is. He asks that, like Him, they be consecrated to God and be his envoys in the world. In these petitions to the Father, the reason for being of the Church and the entire new order of the Church are defined. "I do not pray that you remove them from the world but keep them from evil." He does not ask that they be removed from their environment, he does not ask that they be preserved from the world: they are needed in the world, there is their mission in the world, where they are, and he sends us, and where we are called to let Him be. But they need help from God to be protected from evil. Because the world will hate them, it will not be easy to bear the hatred of others. "Sanctify them in the truth." Sanctify is equivalent to consecrate. What Jesus asks is not simple help for his people. He asks for an authentic inner transformation. He does not ask that you dedicate yourself to the service of the truth. He asks that the Truth transform you. Ask that God make them his own; ask that God consecrate them. My brothers and sisters, let's pray with Jesus and ask the grace of Jesus to make this prayer possible in our lives.

En los evangelios, no solamente encontramos a Jesús orando, no solo lo escuchamos invitándonos a ser hombres y mujeres de oración, sino que también encontramos hermosas oraciones que Jesús mismo oro. Entre las más importantes encontramos: 1. Oración del Padre Nuestro: Esta es considerada la oración más importante enseñada por Jesús a sus discípulos. En ella, Jesús nos enseña a dirigirnos a Dios como Padre y a pedir su voluntad sobre nuestras vidas. 2. Oración en Getsemaní: Antes de ser arrestado y crucificado, Jesús se retiró a orar en el jardín de Getsemaní. En esta oración, Jesús expresó su angustia y entregó su vida a la voluntad del Padre: «Padre, si es tu voluntad, aparta de mí esta copa; pero no se haga mi voluntad, sino la tuya» (Lucas 22:42). 3. Oración en la cruz: Justo antes de morir en la cruz, Jesús pronunció varias oraciones poderosas, incluyendo: «Padre, perdónalos porque no saben lo que hacen» (Lucas 23:34) y «Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?» (Mateo 27:46). Estas oraciones reflejan la compasión y el sufrimiento de Jesús por la humanidad. 4. Oración por sus discípulos: En el capítulo 17 del Evangelio de Juan, Jesús hizo una oración por sus discípulos antes de ser arrestado. En esta oración, Jesús pidió al Padre que los protegiera y los mantuviera unidos: «Santo Padre, a los que me has dado, guárdalos en tu nombre... para que sean uno, así como nosotros somos uno» (Juan 17:11). Estas son solo algunas de las muchas oraciones importantes pronunciadas por Jesús durante su vida terrenal. Cada una revela su profundo vínculo con Dios y su amor por la humanidad.

El evangelio de este VII Domingo de Pascua se centra en esta última oración, la oración por sus discípulos, conocida también como oración sacerdotal. La oración sacerdotal se refiere a la oración de Jesús antes de su arresto. En ella Jesús entrega su testamento espiritual. En este texto, Cristo hace un balance de su vida en el momento de entrar en su Pasión. Se trata de uno de los momentos más intensos de la vida del Maestro.

"Padre santo, guarda en tu nombre a estos que me has dado, para que sean uno como nosotros". Jesús aclara que la unión entre él y los apóstoles no es una simple amistad, algo que termina en el sentimiento. Pide para ellos una unidad tan íntima como la unidad divina. Pide que, aunque sigan en el mundo, estén separados de él como Él mismo lo está. Pide que, como Él, estén totalmente consagrados a Dios y sean sus enviados en el mundo. En estas peticiones al Padre quedan definidos la razón de ser de la Iglesia y todo el nuevo orden de la Iglesia. "No ruego que los retires del mundo, sino que los guardes del mal". No pide que sean sacados de su ambiente, no pide que se les guarde del mundo: Hacen falta en el mundo, ahí está su misión, en el mundo, donde son y somos enviados por Él, y donde nosotros también somos llamados a dejarlo ser a Él. Pero necesitan ayuda de Dios para ser preservados del mal. Porque el mundo los aborrecerá y no será fácil soportar el odio de los demás. "Santifícalos en la verdad". Santificar equivale a consagrar. Lo que pide Jesús no es una simple ayuda para los suyos. Pide una auténtica transformación interior. No pide que se dediquen al servicio de la verdad, pide que sean transformados por la Verdad. Pide que Dios los haga suyos, pide que sean consagrados por Dios.

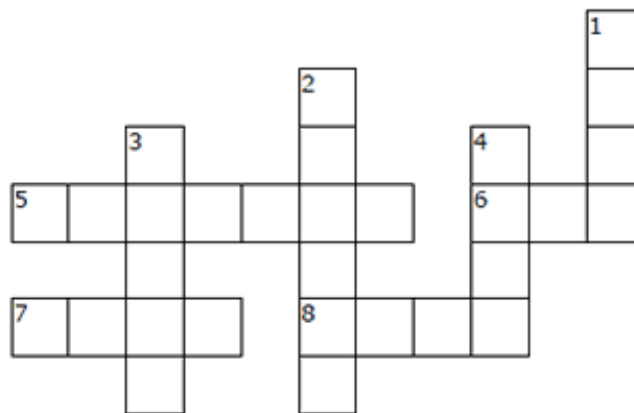
